 HERNY WAS LAME FROM CHILDHOOD DUE TO AN ACCIDENT. HE HAD GREAT MUSICAL TALENT. HE LEAD SINGING SCHOOLS.

**Leonard A. Sage**  
 LENOARD WAS BORN IN LEE COUNTY VA. AND HIS MOTHER DIED AT AN EARLY AGE. HE AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE FAMILY SPENT A LOT OF TIME AT AN AUNT'S HOUSE. HE MOVED TO GRUNDY VA. IN HIS TEENS AND THEN TO BLUEFIELD WV BEFORE THE AGE OF 20. HE WORKED

IN AUTOMOBILE DEALERSHIPS AS A PAINT AND BODY MAN THEN THEN LATER AS A MECHANIC. HE ENJOYED RIDING MOTORCYCLES EARLY IN LIFE BUT QUIT AFTER BEING SLIGHTLY INJURED IN A ACCIDENT. In THEIR EARLY MARRIAGE, HE AND HAZEL CONELY SAGE LIVED ON KEY STREET IN EAST PRINCETON. IN 1957 HE MOVED TO THE NEW HOPE ROAD BETWEEN PRINCETON &BLUEWELL. AFTER THIS MOVE HE BUILT A GARAGE FOR AUTO REPAIRS AT HIS HOME. HE THEN WORKED AT DEALERSHIPS IN TOWN DURING THE DAY AND WOULD WORK IN THE HOME GARAGE TO LATE AT NIGHT AND ON WEEK ENDS. THE BOYS FROM THE FAMILY ALSO HELPED IN THE FAMILY GARAGE AND IN THE GARDEN.

LENOARD SUFFERED FIVE HEART ATTACKS FROM THE AGE OF 32 UNTIL HIS DEATH AT 54 YEARS OF AGE. HE WAS DISABLED AT THE AGE OF 44. Leonad entered the US Army on 1/20/1945 in Hungington WV. His serial number was 35956175.

LEONARD LOVED FISHING AND HUNTING IN LATER LIFE, HE FISHED FOR TROUT AND WAS INVOLVED IN "BULLS-EYE" HAND GUN COMPETITION. HIS WIFE ALSO WENT TROUT FISHING HIM AFTER HE RETIRED ON DISABILITY.
