

No member shall have more than six (6) un-excused absences per year. After twelve (12) absences he or she shall be referred to the Membership Committee for review. If member stays active, they shall go before the Membership Committee after ninety (90) day probation.

A member shall call any officer and can be excused for illness, out-of-town or any other reasonable excuse.

ARTICLE XII: AMENDMENTS

The Constitution may be amended at any business meeting by a 25% of active membership. Proposed amendments shall be submitted to the By-Laws Committee for recommendation to the membership. Such amendments shall be submitted in writing. Amendments shall be recommended to the membership at a regular meeting and voted upon at the next business meeting. All amendments must be approved by the Carroll County Search and Rescue.

ARTICLE XIII: FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Members shall get all financial obligations cleared at the first regular meetings after expenditures. All expenditures over \$100.00 shall be approved by membership, excluding search situations.

ARTICLE XIV: MOTIONS

Any motion made and carried at any business meeting contrary to these Constitution and By-Laws shall be Null and Void.

DISSOLUTION:

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future

federal tax code, or shall be distributed the federal government, or to a state or local government for public purpose.
